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Dr. Eknoyan chaired the Steering Committee of the multi-center HEMO Study and currently chairs the Data Safety Monitoring Board of the Frequent Hemodialysis Study both sponsored by the NIH-NIDDK. He is a founding member, past president and currently secretary-treasurer of the International Association for the History of Nephrology. He has authored over 300 articles and book chapters and serves on the editorial boards of several journals including the *American Journal of Kidney Diseases*, *American Journal of Nephrology*, *Advances in Chronic Kidney Disease*, *Nephrology Dialysis and Transplantation*, *Seminars in Nephrology*, and *Clinical Nephrology*. His memberships include among others the American Society of Nephrology, International Society of Nephrology, American Society of Physiology, European Renal Association and American College of Physician.

Dr. Eknoyan is an honorary member of several national nephrology societies and the recipient of a number of awards including the Award of Excellence of the American Association of Kidney Patients, the Award of Exceptional Leadership of the National Kidney Foundation, the Sandor Koranyi medal of the Hungarian Society of Nephrology, and the Medicus Hippocraticus Prize of the Fondation Internationale Hippocratique.

Dr. Eknoyan received his medical degree from the American University of Beirut and served his residencies at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas, Texas and Boston City Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. He was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow in Kidney and Electrolyte Metabolism at the University of Texas southwestern Medical School in Dallas, Texas.
